GPJE Junior Research Conference

at the Georg-August-University of Göttingen

Prior to the 20th annual conference of the GPJE, the junior research conference will take place at the University of Göttingen.

In order to register for the junior research conference, please use the GPJE's annual conference application form on the corresponding website. Registration will open soon. The programme to the annual conference contains information on accommodation, directions and the conference venue.

There are three options for actively participating in the conference:

1. by giving a lecture/a presentation/a workshop focusing on a PhD/doctoral dissertation project,
2. by giving a lecture/a presentation/a workshop focusing on current research projects or research-accompanied practical examples of civic education,
3. by presenting a scientific poster on a current research project about civic education or a PhD/doctoral dissertation project.

To actively participate by giving a lecture/a presentation/a workshop, please hand in an abstract (four to five lines incl. a title)

Abstracts will be printed in the conference programme. The conference language is German, whispered interpreting (simultaneous interpreting in pairs/small groups) and panels in English are possible.
